A Place at the Table - Support for Syrian Refugees

In view of the current situation in Syria, and the many people who are fleeing from the war there, the Congregational Board decided that we should make the congregation aware of this project proposed by the World Mission Council and encourage them to support it if they can. The Church as a whole is also supporting financially congregations and partner Churches in several countries in Europe where asylum seekers are currently arriving, but A Place at the Table, which has been running for some time, aims to assist the National Evangelical Synod of Syria and Lebanon to reach out to displaced people of all faiths within Syria and in the surrounding countries. The idea is that we use the placemat provided to set an extra place at our table, at home or when eating out, and donate the cost of that extra meal to the project. But be as creative as you like - ask all present to contribute to the extra meal; put out the placemat once a week or even once a day, and collect money little by little; have a minimal meal and donate what you would have spent on your normal meal: invite friends especially for a fundraiser. It is up to you... and if you come up with a novel idea, how about a picture or a news item for the Church website? (Send to strathdrynie@gmail.com). Information sheets and placemats are available as you leave Church. All contributions should be returned by Sunday 29th November - they may be placed in the offering plate in an envelope marked A Place at the Table, or given to any member of the Congregational Board. Many of you will surely be giving individual donations to national and local organisations which are raising funds to help in this crisis, but please give prayerful consideration to taking part in this congregational effort if you can. And of course, everyone can pray for the situation in Syria, those affected, and all those attempting to help in any way.
